WHY WE WORK ON CHILD PROTECTION

16,054 children living in poor & near poor households and disadvantaged families

400,000 children are considered as temporary migrants who have migrated to the city from other provinces either with their parents or independently;

86.4% migrant children drop in primary schools;

interviewed students in a survey were victims of school bullying and 80% of students witnessed school bullying;

1,031,944 children and young people aged 5-17 are subjected to child labour, of which **59%** are boys and **41%** are girls.
