OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

2017

We led a consortium to collaborate with the Disaster Management Policy and Technology Center under the Vietnam Disaster Management Authority, to develop and issue a **practical guidance on** Integration of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) into local Social Economic Development Plan (SEDP). Later on, the practical guidance was one of inputs for the drafting and issuance of the Circular No. 10/2021/TT-BKHDT on integration of DRR into SEDP issued by the Ministry of Planning and Investment in 2021.

2019

We contributed technical support to the Ministry of Education and Training (MOET) to develop and endorse a guidance on **safe school framework** for implementation nationwide; and to promote a documentation on safe school best practices and lessons learnt.

2019-2021

We worked with UN's Food & Agriculture Organization (FAO), UN Women, Vietnam Institute of Meteorology, Hydrology and Environment (IMHEN) and Disaster Management Policy and Technology Center (DMPTC) to build up drought impacted forecasting map in Gia Lai province, which is now integrated into the Vietnam Disaster Monitoring System.

2020

We provided supports for **flooding response** that worth **1.14** million USD for flood-affected communities.
