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# EDUCATION IN VIETNAM



Save the Children's Education program in Vietnam aims to **increase access to quality learning** (including digital literacy) for the most deprived children and youth.

## WHY WE WORK ON EDUCATION

Only **1.75**  
teacher/students

Lower compared to the recommended ratio of **2-2.5**

**21.1%**

preschool teachers are **under standard qualification**.

**Limitations & Challenges**

in terms of resources, infrastructure, facilities, professional capacity.

## OUR TARGET GROUP

We help the most deprived and disadvantaged groups of children and youth access to quality education, including:



Poor or near-poor children.



Ethnic minority children.



Migrants.

## OUR INTERVENTIONS

**Early Childhood Care and Development** focusing on literacy-numeracy, physical, socio-emotional and learning.

**Basic Education** focusing on reading proficiency.

**Adolescent Skills for Successful Transition** focusing on youth employment.

In all areas, we have been integrating different **digital transformation** solutions.

## OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

We successfully achieved overall objective in enhancing the **School Readiness and Learning Outcomes** of ethnic minority children aged 3-11 in Yen Bai and Quang Nam:

- Overall development score of preschool students **increased from 36% to 63%**;
- Proportion of readers with comprehension of primary students **increased from 20% to 44%**.

Our common approaches on education, including **Ready to Learn** (for 3-to-6-year-old) and **Literacy Boost** (for 6-to-11-year-old) have been embedded in **National Annual Teacher Training Program** of Ministry of Education and Training (MOET).

We supported the Agency of Teachers & Education Administrators (ATEA) under MOET to develop a module on **Mother-tongue based Multi-Lingual Education** for pre-school teachers in education universities and colleges in areas that have ethnic minority children.
