

CHILD RIGHTS GOVERNANCE



- **SURVIVE:** No child dies from preventable causes before their fifth birthday.
- **LEARN:** All children learn from a quality basic education.
- **BE PROTECTED:** Violence against children is no longer tolerated.

receives the essential services they deserve. Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Emergency Response (ER) continues as one of our key cross cutting priorities, in addition to ensuring gender-sensitive programming and meaningful child participation across all programs.

EDUCATION

Save the Children works to improve the quality of education for ethnic minority children in Vietnam. We support Emergent Literacy and Math skills in early childhood development programs and work to ensure equal opportunities in basic education for ethnic minority children. We support mother tongue language instruction for these children, as well as Literacy Boost to improve their reading skills.

CHILD PROTECTION

Save the Children provides direct support to vulnerable children and protects them from violence, abuse, trafficking and exploitation.

We campaign for the elimination of physical and humiliating punishment, establishment of a monitoring and reporting mechanism on child abuse and also facilitation and development of training modules on child protection for social workers.

HEALTH & NUTRITION

Save the Children helps to improve the quality of maternal, newborn and child health. We work with partners to improve the nutritional status of children through promotion of adequate infant and young child feeding practices in the first 1,000 days, early initiation and exclusive breastfeeding, integrated management of acute malnutrition and promotion of household food security and dietary diversity.

CHILD POVERTY

Save the Children works to alleviate childhood poverty by building employability skills and life skills of migrant youth, providing job linkages and networking, advocating for employee social protection, building entrepreneurial skills and promoting financial education.
